Wilderness Upgrade for Medical Professionals (WUMP)

April 24–30, 2009

The WUMP course prepares you to make though decision in tough environments. Whether you operate in an urban or rural setting with limited resources and communication challenges, this course will help build your improvisation and decision-making skills. The unique course includes advanced topics as dislocation reduction, focused spinal assessment, wound closure, litter packaging and medication administration. The intense six day course is ideal for EMTs, First Responders, Nurses, Physicians and other medical providers. The course employs a hands-on curriculum scenarios, mock rescues and case studies specially tailored for this unique remote mountain location. This course is approved for 48 hours EMT CEUs by CECBEMS and 36 hours (Category I) Physician CMEs.

The course will be conducted at *The Mountain Institute's Spruce Knob Center*. This beautiful rustic preserve is nestled on West Virginia's highest mountain – Spruce Knob. The center boasts 400 acres of high elevation pasture and woods surrounded by the one million acre Monongahela National Forest.
