**September 11 – 17, 2009**

**Friday evening through Thursday morning**

The WUMP course prepares you to make tough decisions in tough environments. Whether you operate in an urban or rural setting with limited resources and communication challenges, this course will help build your improvisation and decision-making skills. The unique course includes advanced topics as dislocation reduction, focused spinal assessment, wound closure, litter packaging and medication administration. The intense five day course is ideal for First Responders, EMTs, Paramedics, Nurses, Physicians and other medical providers. The course employs a hands-on curriculum scenarios, mock rescues and case studies specially tailored for unique remote locations. This course is approved for 48 hours EMT CEUs by CECBEMS and 36 hours (Category I) Physician CMEs.

The course will be conducted at the Greenbrier County Youth Camp in Anthony, WV in Greenbrier County, WV.
