

Class 3 IFT-Paramedic Treatment Protocol **3202**

Chest Pain

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This protocol is utilized when the patient is being treated for chest pain and in need of interfacility transfer.

- A. Perform Inter-Facility Transport Assessment (IFTA) Procedures Patient Care Protocol 9204 and follow the proper protocol for medical management based on clinical presentation.
- B. Review 12 lead and all patient records at sending facility.
- C. If chest pain worsens enroute to receiving facility, repeat the ECG, follow guideline for **Vasodilator Protocol 3203.** If changes in ECG and or new onset AMI:

Notify MCP for consideration of alternate destination.

- D. If the patient develops a new onset of chest pain follow guidelines for **Chest Pain Protocol 4202.**
- E. Monitor any medications from the below categories as prescribed by the sending physician:
 - 1. Vasodilators- Refer to Vasodilators Protocol 3203
 - 2. Vasopressor- Refer to Vasopressor Protocol 3204
 - 3. Antiplatelet- Refer to Antiplatelet Protocol 3215
 - 4. Anticoagulants Refer to Anticoagulant Protocol 3216
 - 5. Fibrinolytics Refer to Fibrinolytic Protocol 3217
 - 6. Antidysrhhymias- Refer to Anti-arrhythmic Protocol 3208
