

## Class 3 IFT-Paramedic Treatment Protocol 3217

**Fibrinolytic** 

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This protocol is utilized when the patient has been administered or is actively receiving fibrinolytic therapy and in need of interfacility transfer.

- A. Perform Inter-Facility Transport Assessment (IFTA) Procedures Patient Care Protocol 9204 and follow the proper protocol for medical management based on clinical presentation.
- B. If actively infusing, monitor the fibrinolytic medication as prescribed by the sending physician.
- C. When monitoring anticipate short cycles of ventricular tachycardia and spontaneous arrhythmias that often resolve on their own.
  - 1. Monitor the patient and recheck vital signs if these occur.
  - 2. If arrhythmias or changes in the patient's status/vitals occur that last more than a few minutes:

## D. Consult Medical Command



- E. Monitor the fibrinolytic medication for any of the following side effects:
  - 1. Nose Bleed/uncontrolled bleeding
  - 2. Severe abdominal pain
  - 3. Obvious blood in urine
  - 4. Obvious blood in stool
  - 5. Obvious vomiting of blood
  - 6. Obvious severe back pain
- F. If any of the above side effects occur; discontinue medication and **consult**MCP
