

## Class 3 IFT-Paramedic Treatment Protocol 3602

Antibiotic Page 1 of 1

Any antibiotic must have been infusing for at least 15 minutes prior to transport and determination made that patient is not experiencing an allergic reaction to the medication.

A. Perform Class 3 IFTA Protocol 9204. Perform Inter-Facility Transport Assessment (IFTA) Procedures Patient Care Protocol 9204 and follow the proper protocol for medical management based on clinical presentation.

## B. Treatment:

- 1. Continue infusion rates as set by the sending physician.
- C. Monitor patient for symptoms of an allergic reaction: rash, hives, dyspnea, itching, and/or tachycardia.
- If symptoms occur, stop the infusions, refer to Allergic Reaction/Anaphylaxis Protocol 4501 and consult MCP for further orders.
