

Class 3 IFT-Paramedic Treatment Protocol 3607

GI/GU Electrolytes

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This protocol covers transport of patients being transported for treatment of disorders of the gastrointestinal tract.

- A. Perform Inter-Facility Transport Assessment (IFTA) Procedures Patient Care Protocol 9204 and follow the proper protocol for medical management based on clinical presentation.
- B. Proton Pump Inhibitors
 - a. Treatment
 - i. Monitor for headaches, gastrointestinal bleeding, nausea, diarrhea, abdominal pain, itching, or rash.
 - If any of the above conditions occur, discontinue medication and
 - 2. Contact Medical Command on consultation to discontinue I.V. infusion



- C. Electrolytes
 - a. Continue infusion rates as ordered by the sending physician.
 - b. Assess IV sites for signs of infiltration
 - c. Monitor patients for arrhythmias, confusion, restlessness, or ECG Widening.
 - d. If symptoms occur, contact Medical Command



- D. Octreotide acetate (Sandostatin)
 - a. Continue infusion rates as ordered by the sending physician.
 - b. Monitor for arrhythmias, bradycardia, cardiac conduction disturbance, CHF exacerbation.
 - c. If symptoms occur, contact Medical Command



- E. Nutrition
 - a. Continue infusion rate as ordered by the sending physician
 - b. Assess IV site for infiltration
 - c. If complications occur, contact Medical Command
