

Class 3 IFT-Paramedic Treatment Protocol 3215

Antiplatelet Page 1 of 1

This protocol is utilized when the patient is being treated with antiplatelet medications.

- A. Perform Inter-Facility Transport Assessment (IFTA) Procedures Patient Care Protocol 9204 and follow the proper protocol for medical management based on clinical presentation.
- B. Monitor the antiplatelet medication as prescribed by the sending physician.
- C. Monitor the antiplatelet medication for any of the following side effects:
 - 1. Nose Bleed/uncontrolled bleeding
 - 2. Severe abdominal pain
 - 3. Obvious Blood in urine
 - 4. Obvious blood in stool
 - 5. Obvious vomiting of blood
 - 6. Sudden severe back pain
- D. If any of the above side effects occur: discontinue medication and consultMCP
