

THE STROKE BELT

The country's highest death rates from stroke are in the southeastern U.S., **known as the Stroke Belt**.

The overall deaths from stroke is **20% higher** than the U.S. average.

COMMON RISK FACTORS

Most Americans have at least 1 risk factor:



RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS USING THE F.A.S.T. TEST:

FACE: Ask the person to smile. Does one side of the face droop?

ARMS: Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downwards?

SPEECH: Ask the person to repeat a simple sentance. Are words slurred?

TIME: If the person shows any of thse symptoms, please call 911 or get to the hospital immediately.
