

# Temporary Relief of Initial EMT Patient Contact Requirement

**PURPOSE:** To provide temporary relief of the ten (10) patient contact requirement for Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) students allowing for National Registry testing.

**POLICY:** This policy applies to initial EMT courses and alters the requirement for ten (10) patient contacts prior to National Registry testing during the COVID-19 pandemic. This relief policy shall be effective and **ONLY** apply to EMT courses ending prior to July 1, 2020.

### **PROCEDURE/REQUIREMENTS:**

Beginning immediately, any Initial EMT class scheduled to end prior to July 1, 2020, may follow the below-listed process in order to allow for National Registry testing:

- A. EMT students will not be required to complete ten (10) patient contacts **prior** to completing the course and testing National Registry.
- B. EMT students will complete the West Virginia Office of Emergency Medical Services (WVOEMS) initial EMT State Education Tracking System (SETS) application and ECERT application.
- C. The WVOEMS will process the application; however, will **not** issue a WVOEMS certification card.
- D. EMT students will be required to complete a minimum of ten (10) patient contacts serving as a student in the presence of an approved Preceptor from the Educational Institute.
- E. EMT students and the primary provider will be required to complete the run tracking report for each patient contact.
- F. EMT students will submit the ten (10) run tracking reports via email to the WVOEMS education coordinator at [Jerry.L.Mullins@wv.gov](mailto:Jerry.L.Mullins@wv.gov). A WVOEMS certification card will be issued at that time.
