RE: EMS Prehospital Providers Conducting COVID-19 Vaccinations

EMS agencies who have expressed an interest in assisting with COVID-19 vaccinations, must ensure their employees have taken the vaccination training. This training will be conducted through the RETI Blackboard. Individuals are to follow these steps:

- 1. Go to http://wvreti.org/
- 2. Click on "Open LMS"
- 3. If you already have an account, sign in
- 4. If you do not have an account, you will need to create an account.
- 5. Scroll down the page to the course "COVID Vaccination Administration Training"
- 6. Select "enroll me"
- 7. Complete ALL requirements

Individuals completing this course must provide a copy of their certificate to their EMS Agency Training Officer for record keeping.

A Department of Health and Human Resources representative will be in contact with interested EMS agencies when assistance is need for vaccinations. Vaccination personnel MUST be certified at a minimum at the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) level and have completed the COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Training.
